If your child is in Y3 and above and you wish for them to receive these Sacraments then please get in touch with the office as soon as possible, to enable them to be adequately prepared.

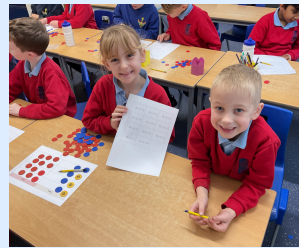
