Dear Jesus

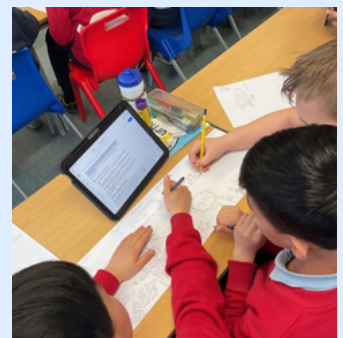
As we get closer to Easter, help us to leave behind our mistakes and our worries. Fill our hearts with your light so that we can be kind, helpful, and brave.
