As we end the penultimate week of the term, our school corridors are filled with the spirit of Palm Sunday. This week, our EYFS children led a Celebration of the Word for their families marking Jesus' humble entry into Jerusalem—a time of celebration, community, and great hope.

This coming Sunday is Palm Sunday, the beginning of Holy Week and the most sacred time in our Church calendar. It is a time when we transition from the joyful shouts of "Hosanna" to a period of quiet reflection on the values of sacrifice and love.

Next week the curriculum will focus on walking through Holy Week together. On Monday, a group of our Y3 children will lead us in a Palm Sunday reflection.

On Tuesday, some of our Y4 children will remind us of Maundy Thursday, when Jesus had his last supper with the disciples.

A collection of Y5 children, on Wednesday, will continue to reflect on Maundy Thursday, to focus our minds on the washing of feet, where Jesus washed his disciples' feet to show us that to be a leader, we must first be a servant.

Finally, on Thursday, a few Y6 children will lead our reflection of Good Friday, a quiet solemn occasion, where we remember Jesus' great love for us on the cross. Please feel free to join us, if you are able, from 9.10am each day. It would be lovely to walk through Holy Week together.

SUMMER SCHOOL UNIFORM

White socks

Black shoes

Please make sure that your child has a coat with them, even if the weather looks promising or you travel to school by car. The children will be playing outside and they will soon feel cold or damp.

It is important to mark every item of uniform clearly with your child's name.

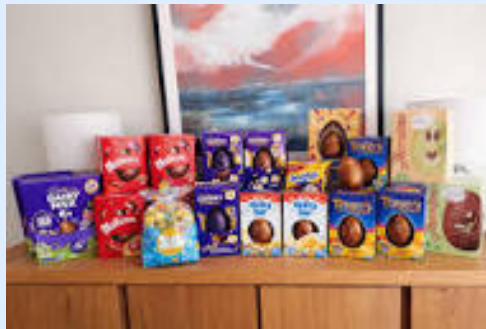
