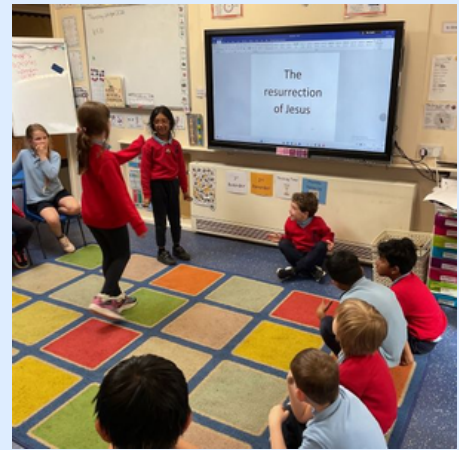
Further prayers required for a dry sunny weekend for us all, I think.
